

Local Funding Application Instructions

One of the goals of the **BFCL** initiative is to provide local leaders with the resources they need to strengthen their local associations and get more members actively involved. **BFCL** funds are available to support **NEW** ideas, activities and programs, especially those designed to engage members or increase member political awareness/engagement. Any local (or group of locals) dedicated to developing its capacity is eligible to receive funds to support a **NEW** program, training or activity.

It's EASY to request funds:

- Take the **BFCL** Self-Assessment (available at www.mea.org or by contacting Donna Wickham in the Field Services Department at dwickham@mea.org).
- Identify one or more of the **BFCL** indicators on which your local will focus as a result of the Self-Assessment.
- Set some **specific** goals and develop a plan for reaching those goals.
- Completely fill out the BFCL Local Funding Application.

Please note:

- The funding request must be received four weeks prior to your event for processing purposes.
- \checkmark You must be a member in good standing to receive funding.
- BFCL funding is available one time per year for any local and can be used for materials, mileage, refreshments, and up to five \$20 gift cards. It cannot be used for alcoholic beverages. MEA will not approve purchases from Sam's Club or Walmart.
- Save your detailed receipts. You must submit your receipts to BFCL in order to receive any funding in the future.
- Excess money needs to be returned by check made out to MEA.
