General ESP Certificate Program – Track I

The Education Support Professionals (ESP) Certificate Program, administered by the Michigan ESP Center for Professional Learning, assures the provision of high quality standards-based professional development for Education Support Professionals.

Supported by the Michigan Education Association (MEA), the General ESP Certificate – Track I is available to all ESP in any classification (both MEA members and non-members) who complete the program requirements. The Instructional Paraprofessional ESP Certificate – Track II is available for instructional paraprofessionals who are required by the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA)/No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2001 to be “qualified.”

The following application is to be used only by ESP who have completed the 40 hour curriculum requirement for the General ESP Certificate Program – Track I (i.e. those who are not impacted by the ESEA/NCLB).

ESP Program Certificates are issued as a courtesy to MEA members at no cost. Non-members are required to submit a fee of \$30.00 as part of the application process. A check or money order should be made payable to Michigan Education Association.
