**Setting Short and Long-term Student Learning Goals and Managing Evaluation Data** Often the teacher evaluation system is overwhelming. You know you are a good teacher, but how do you demonstrate that to your evaluator in a way that is not too cumbersome for you? In this session, participants will learn the importance of setting and documenting student goals, involving students in the process, and how to create evidence to support your success in the classroom so the teacher evaluation is manageable. **February 26, 2024 6 p.m.**

**Analyzing Student Learning Data.** In this session, participants will learn how to utilize assessments to their advantage to improve student outcomes and adapt instruction to support learning. We will briefly discuss standardized testing but will focus on the assessments that are most effective for guiding instruction and learning. We will demonstrate how to analyze assessment results and create a learning plan responsive to those results. **March 25, 2024 6 p.m.**

**Engagement Strategies.** In this session, participants will discuss instructional strategies and learn how social emotional learning and DEI (diversity, equity, inclusion) play a role in helping to support ALL students in their quest to be independent learners.
