

Who are we?

Educators Rising is our middle and high school-level program for aspiring educators. Whether part of a CTE program or a school-based club, our goal is to support these students in pursuing their interest in and developing the skills necessary for a career in education. We offer teacher resources to help students network, develop leadership skills, and showcase the expertise they have gained in their education and training programs through state and national conferences and competitions.

What is the purpose of Educators Rising?

Educators Rising supports middle and high school students who are pursuing a career in education. It helps students learn more about careers and opportunities in education; it supports their development of the skills necessary to become effective practitioners; it provides opportunities to earn college credit, network with other future educators and professionals, and showcase their talents in state and national competitions.

Who is eligible to join?

Middle or high school students interested in pursuing a career in education. Most often schools have chapters and encourage their students to join. If your school doesn't have a chapter but does have a course or club, encourage your teacher to become a teacher leader and create a chapter at your school. If your school doesn't have a course or club and you can't create one, you can join on your own.

How can I join?
