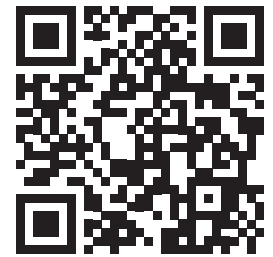


Supporting students amid immigration fear and uncertainty
