This is the 60-Day packet for the MEA RA. We will send pertinent information from previously emailed packets in the 30-day packet as well.

**Proposed Amendments and New Business Items:** The Blank Dues Amendment is attached. We strongly encourage the submission of new business items (NBIs) to the Resolutions Committee prior to the first general session of the RA. Submitting NBIs early allows more time to gather information for deliberations. **The deadline for submission of NBIs is Friday, April 17, by 5:30 p.m. or one hour after the close of session, whichever is earlier.** Please use the fillable forms attached and email your request to the Resolutions Committee.

**Registration Required:** You must register for the MEA RA **by April 7** to allow us to coordinate meals and materials for the RA. To register, go to the Members Only website at [www.mea.org/login](http://www.mea.org/login). Once logged in, click on Event Registration under Tools & Benefits then click on 2025 Representative Assembly. **If you do not have a login ID and password to the [Members Only website](http://www.mea.org/login), please sign up. After registering for the MEA RA, an automatic confirmation will be emailed to you. If you have any problems registering or didn't receive your confirmation email, please send an email to [mea\\_ra@mea.org](mailto:mea_ra@mea.org).**

**Attendance/Credentials:** Delegates must complete the registration above. If you cannot attend the RA, be sure to notify your local president and/or region chair immediately so that a duly elected alternate can attend. All changes in delegates must be made in writing and emailed to [mea\\_ra@mea.org](mailto:mea_ra@mea.org). For ease in notifying your local president, the Notice to Seat Alternate Form (from delegate to local president) is attached. If an alternate delegate's official Notice to Seat Alternate Form has not been received at [mea\\_ra@mea.org](mailto:mea_ra@mea.org), the alternate delegate will not be allowed to participate in the RA. These steps are necessary in order to prevent misuse of credentials and to meet the requirements of the Landrum-Griffin Act.

**Special Interest Caucus meetings:** If you are a chairperson of an MEA-recognized caucus and would like to hold a meeting during the MEA RA, please contact [mea\\_ra@mea.org](mailto:mea_ra@mea.org) to let us know and we will determine if we have a meeting room the caucus could use Friday or Saturday before/after the general sessions(s).

**New Delegate Orientation:** New Delegate Orientation will be in a virtual format on Monday, April 6, from 6:00-7:30 p.m.

The MEA RA will be held April 17-18, 2026. The following reflects administrative policies regarding the seating of delegates:

**[Delegate seating for locals whose individual members pay dues directly to MEA \(IBL and IPDD\)](#)**

The Credentials Committee shall seat delegates based upon each local's member-in-good-standing count as of March 1, 2026:

- a. Local and region leaders will be notified electronically of their preliminary member-in-good-standing counts and their resulting delegate eligibility as of January 1, 2026. Notice will be sent by January 19, 2026.
- b. Local and region leaders will be notified electronically in the 30-day RA mailing of their final member-in-good-standing counts and their resulting delegate eligibility as of March 1, 2026.
- c. Locals that realize an increase in their member-in-good-standing count prior to the RA may apply to the Credentials Committee to have the additional delegates seated according to the following schedule:
  - i. Locals with a total membership count of greater than 56, and a member-in-good-standing count below 56 as of March 1, 2026, may (until 14 days prior to the RA) request reinstatement of their delegate(s) if the local's member-in-good-standing count on the ME678 report exceeds 55 members.
  - ii. Locals eligible for more than one delegate whose member-in-good-standing count as of March 1, 2026 is less than 226 but greater than 55, and whose member-in-good standing count after March 1, 2026, (as verified on the MEA ME678 report) qualifies for additional delegates, may apply to the Credentials Committee for seating of their additional delegates until the RA is called to order.

**[Delegate seating for locals that transmit dues on behalf of its members \(LBL\)](#)**

The Credentials Committee shall seat the delegates based on the local's report of members-in-good standing according to the following process:

- a. Local and region leaders will be notified electronically of their estimated preliminary member-in-good-standing counts based upon dues transmitted to MEA by each local and their resulting estimated delegate eligibility as of January 1, 2026. Notice will be sent by January 19, 2026.
- b. Local and region leaders will be notified electronically in the 30-day RA packet of their estimated final member-in-good-standing counts and their resulting delegate eligibility as of March 1, 2026.

- c. After receiving the March 1, 2026 estimated member-in-good-standing and delegate count, local presidents who believe their locals qualify for additional delegates may email [mea\\_ra@mea.org](mailto:mea_ra@mea.org) to report their member-in-good-standing counts based on the records of the local.
- d. Locals self-reporting a member-in-good-standing count that is inconsistent with dues transmitted to MEA will be contacted to reconcile the discrepancy and determine correct seating eligibility.
- e. Locals that realize an increase in their member-in-good-standing count prior to the RA may apply to the Credentials Committee to have the additional delegates seated according to the following schedule:
  - i. Locals with a total membership count of greater than 56, and a member-in-good-standing count below 56 as of March 1, 2026, may (until 14 days prior to the RA) request reinstatement of their delegate(s) if the local's member-in-good-standing count on the ME678 report exceeds 55 members.
  - ii. Locals eligible for more than one delegate whose member-in-good-standing count as of March 1, 2026 is less than 226 but greater than 55, and whose member-in-good standing count after March 1, 2026 (as verified on the MEA ME678 report) qualifies for additional delegates, may apply to the Credentials Committee for seating of their additional delegates until the RA is called to order.

#### **Seating of Cluster Delegates and Alternates**

- a. Locals that, as of June 30, 2025, qualified for their own RA delegate(s), but whose March 1, 2026 member-in-good-standing count is less than 56, shall have the number of members in good standing added to the appropriate cluster from their region.
- b. If the addition of members under subparagraph a. above results in a cluster qualifying to seat an additional delegate(s), MEA will notify duly elected alternates that they may be seated at the RA. Final notice of seating for alternates will take place 14 days prior to the RA.
- c. Region presidents and cluster alternates will be notified by MEA of tentative seating eligibility following the March 1, 2026 count, and seating eligibility will be confirmed after the 14-day deadline for stand-alone units to have delegate seating reinstated.

The following information will assist you in determining which regions are "in play" with respect to the upcoming commission elections at the 2026 MEA Representative Assembly (RA). As you know, our bylaws state "the membership of a commission shall at no time include more than two members from any one region of the Association." Further, "this requirement shall not apply to NEA State Directors as members of commissions."

At this time, we are accepting nominations for the Legislation Commission and the Local Affiliates Commission. Members may be nominated one of two ways: run from the floor of the RA or be nominated by petition of at least 15 delegates submitted to the MEA Executive Director by **April 3rd**. Nominating petitions are included in this delegate packet.

#### Legislation Commission

- We will elect **one member** for a partial term beginning immediately and ending August 31, 2028.
- We will elect **two members** for three-year terms beginning September 1, 2026 and ending August 31, 2029.

One member from Region 6 (Brad Wenz) is eligible to be nominated and re-elected.

One member from Region 7 (Joseph Humphrey) is eligible to be nominated and re-elected.

No more than one member from Regions 3, 5, 7, 9 or 10 may be nominated and elected.

No more members from Region 2 or 12 may be nominated and elected.

MEA Board members are ineligible for RA elected commission seats.

#### Local Affiliates Commission

- We will elect **one member** for a partial term beginning immediately and ending August 31, 2026.
- We will elect **two members** for three-year terms beginning September 1, 2026 and ending August 31, 2029.

One member from Region 7 (Richard Tabor) is eligible to be nominated and re-elected.

No more than one member from Regions 3, 11 or 12 may be nominated and elected.

No more members from Region 2, 5, 6, or 8 may be nominated and elected.

MEA Board members are ineligible for RA elected commission seats.
