**Text of proposal:**

The MEA RA directs MEA Leadership to support Michigan Senate Bill 510 which would require federal ICE officers to have active body cameras, visible identification, and not wear masks. MEA will inform members of such support via MEA publications.

**Rationale:**

The purpose of ICE agents being unidentifiable is to ensure that there are no consequences for ICE actions which may be illegal and possibly harmful or deadly to citizens and residents. Agent identification decreases the possibility of such actions establishing a higher level of protection for students and families from unwarranted assault, injury, and/or abuse of their legal rights.
